



Enrollment Checklist

2021-2022 Academic Year

Step #1: Visit

- Attend a Tuesday Open House or schedule a time for a tour.

Step #2: Apply

- Complete a New Student Admissions Application.

Step #3: Inform

- Upon receiving your student's application, you will be contacted by Darren Kloepper, Head of School, to schedule a Family Interview.

Step #4: Meet

- Complete the scheduled Family Interview. Students in grades 5th-12th are to complete a separate Student Interview but will be scheduled alongside the Family Interview.

Step #5: Assess

- Students in grades K-7th will be academically screened to ensure appropriate grade level placement.

Step #6: Enroll

- Submit the Enrollment Registration form and non-refundable* \$100 fee per family. *This fee is non-refundable with enrollment *acceptance*.

Step #7: Receive

- After the interviews are completed, you will be contacted by our Head of School with your enrollment status.

Step #8: Submit

- After the interviews are completed, you will be contacted by our Head of School with your enrollment status.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION for all accepted new students:

- Birth Certificate: A certified/state issued birth certificate must be viewed, copied and verified by Three Oaks Staff.
- Immunization Record: Before starting at Three Oaks Christian School, all new students are required to have an Official Record of Immunizations on file or a signed exemption/waiver.
- Court documentation in the event of custody issues.
- Photo ID of legal parent(s)/guardian(s).
- Signed Record Release Form for student records, if your child is transferring from another School or educational agency. A parent signature is required on this TOCS provided form.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS & DOCUMENTATION:

Middle School & High School Level (7th – 12th grade) :

- Transcript(s) from previous educational agency(ies), including home school, showing classes taken, curriculum used and percentage grading information.
- Course Selection Worksheet

Upon acceptance, additional forms are required. These forms will be available at the Back-to-School Event, prior to the first day of school.

- Handbook Acknowledgement
 - Doctrinal Statement
 - Student Conduct Covenant
 - Home & School Partnership Program Agreement (3 Day Program Only)
 - Enrollment & Tuition Policy Agreement
- Release Form (Medical, Travel & General)
- Photography / Technology / Uniform
- Approved Pick-Up
- Vehicle Registration Form (student drivers only)
