

## Uniform Descriptions

### **Dress Uniform**

- Dress uniforms are worn by all grades on **Tuesday** each week.
- Dress uniforms are worn for Recitation Days, Special Assemblies, School Academic Competitions, Choir Concerts, Graduation, or other named events.
- Dress uniforms or any Dress item may be worn on other days of the week.

### **Casual Uniform**

- K-12<sup>th</sup> – Casual uniform days are Monday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday.

### **Physical Education Attire**

- K – 4<sup>th</sup> will need gym shoes only for PE. Students will remain in their uniform for PE class.
- 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> will arrive at school in their PE uniform on the day they have PE class and change into their school uniform following gym class
  - Modest (mid-thigh) navy or gray solid athletic short
  - Non-marking running shoes
  - Uniform t-shirt (additional clean shirt for the remainder of the school day)
  - Sports bra for girls
- Note: Confirm your child has PE class before ordering.

### Special Notes:

1. Required items are available at these two uniform providers.
2. Specific items for TOCS will be listed under our school program at both Bear's Den and Global Schoolwear. Only order items from the options listed on our program. Clothing that does not match the item numbers and descriptions from our program should not be worn to school. \*The only exception to this rule is a similar navy girls' sweater that may be purchased elsewhere but **MUST** be approved by Administration.

## General Uniform Requirements

### Clothing Guidelines

1. The goal of our uniform policy is to contribute to an environment of academics, modesty and community spirit for TOCS students.
2. Everything worn, and the manner in which it is worn, should complement the overall appearance of the uniform and not compete or distract from it.
3. Uniforms should be clean and well-fitting, in good repair, and the proper length. (See below)  
As children grow, parents should replace items.
  - Girls: Skirts at modest length 1-2" above the knee
  - Boys: Pants should meet the top of the shoe
4. Only the uniform cardigan sweater or embroidered Three Oaks outerwear are permitted in the classroom over standard uniform pieces.
5. Plain white t-shirts only may be worn under shirts.
6. Modifications (i.e., hem, take-in, etc.) may not be made to uniform shorts.

### Personal Grooming & Accessories

#### Grooming

1. Hair should be neatly groomed, not cover the eyes or face, and not dyed any unnatural color.
2. Conservative makeup may be worn by girls in 7th-12th grade.

#### Accessories

1. Jewelry should be minimal, simple, and non-distracting.
2. Hair accessories should be simple, must match the uniform and should not be excessive (e.g. large bows, headbands wider than 2").
3. No visible tattoos, ear gauges or body piercings (other than earrings on girls).

\*The faculty and administration reserve the discretion to require students to modify any element of dress or appearance that is inconsistent with the culture of the school.
